COSMETIC CLAIMS

Cosmetic surgery is rising in popularity and more readily available than ever. In 2016 over 59,000 cosmetic surgery procedures took place.

Deciding to have a cosmetic surgery procedure can be stressful and expensive, often costing thousands of pounds. Understandably, your expectations of the procedure and the final outcome will be high.

Any surgery should be completed by a qualified medical professional. Your Doctor or Surgeon should advise you on the procedure, recovery and any risks, before allowing you to make a decision.

If you have had cosmetic surgery and think that something went wrong, the impact upon you can be both physical and emotional.

You may have a claim for compensation if:

- You weren't given the correct information about the risks associated with your procedure.
- You were not given any aftercare or follow-up advice which impacted upon your recovery.
- A faulty product was used (i.e. breast implant).
- The procedure was not completed to an acceptable standard.

CLINICAL NEGLIGENCE

We put our trust in the hands of professionals but unfortunately, mistakes happen and can have a significant impact on a person's life.

Medical professionals are obligated to provide an adequate level of care and to protect you from harm. This is known as a duty of care and if breached and harm was caused as a direct result, may be classed as negligence.

Making a claim for medical negligence compensation can be complicated, stressful and timely. We have a team of experts that can review your situation in a friendly and sympathetic manner and advise on whether we can pursue a claim for clinical negligence compensation on your behalf.



ROAD TRAFFIC ACCIDENT

Road Traffic Accidents can be extremely distressing for victims and their families. It isn't only drivers of cars on the road; motorbikes, passengers, cyclists, and pedestrians can also be involved in a road traffic accident that wasn't their fault and may be entitled to personal injury compensation.

If a road traffic accident is caused by a cyclist or pedestrian you may still be able to claim for personal injury compensation, even though it is unlikely that they would have insurance so you should speak to a personal injury solicitor for more information.

EMPLOYER LIABILITY

Employers are legally responsible for the health and safety of their employees while they are at work; a duty of care.

According to the Labour Force Survey, in 2015/16, 621,000 injuries occurred at work.

Your employer should maintain health and safety requirements and it is compulsory that your employer has insurance in place to cover any claims for compensation.

If you have an accident at work that was due to your employer's breach of duty, you may be entitled to compensation.

INDUSTRIAL DISEASE

Industrial disease will typically involve exposure in the workplace to some harmful substance, work practice or noise level over an extended period.


Surveys in 2015 suggest that 1.3 million working people suffer from a work-related illness with 2,542 mesothelioma deaths due to past asbestos exposures.

When you are making an industrial injury claim, you will need to be able to prove that your working environment and your employer's negligence resulted in your condition.

PUBLIC LIABILITY

If you are on public property and suffer a personal injury through no fault of your own, you may be able to make a compensation claim against the owner of that property. The owner of the property should have a public liability insurance policy to cover the cost of a compensation claim.

Typical examples of accidents on public property are a slip or trip in the street, fall in the supermarket or accident due to a poorly lit public area.



HOUSING DISREPAIR

A housing tenancy agreement should include the landlord's obligations to carry out repairs. If the tenant has reported a need for repair and the landlord has failed to act, the tenant may be entitled to compensation.

You may be able to claim compensation for damage to your health, your belongings, the inconvenience of not being able to use your home in the usual way, as well as forcing your landlord to carry out repairs to your property.

The claim process includes writing to your landlord on your behalf and arranging for an independent Chartered Surveyor to inspect your home and prepare a report if your landlord is unwilling to undertake the repairs.

CAVITY WALL INSULATION CLAIMS

Not all homes are suitable for cavity wall.

If you have had cavity wall insulation, it may have been installed incorrectly.

You could claim compensation for damage caused to your home, loss of value and for illness arising from the cavity wall being incorrectly installed.


